



UNIFORM POLICY

Underpinning Principles

- Having a consistent, modern and attractive school uniform enhances student pride in our school.
- Complete uniformity in what students wear takes pressure off parents to purchase more expensive name brand clothing and means all students are on “equal footing”, in relation to image.
- Having the students in readily recognisable school uniform presents a good image of the school and is an important safety factor when students are on excursion.
- School short sleeved polo shirt, hooded jumper, crew neck jumper and hooded jacket with the Hendon logo are available from **Lowes at West Lakes.**

- **Navy blue** is the school colour.
- All tops to include school logo.
- All “bottoms” ie. Shorts (mid-thigh length), pants, skirts, track pants etc. to be navy blue.
- Polo shirts, jumpers and jackets to be navy blue with school logo
- Tops worn underneath school uniform that are visible must be navy blue or white.
- Dresses to be blue and white check.
- Tights and stockings worn under school uniform must be navy blue.
- Broad brimmed navy hats in good condition (Faded, frayed or drawn on hats are not acceptable).
- Year 7 students are able to purchase “special” commemorative tops to celebrate their final year in primary school.
- Name tags included with each garment. **Please label all clothes.**
- Also available from the school office are **scarves, beanies, scrunchies, headbands and hats.**

All students (including male and female) with shoulder length hair must have their hair tied back with a hair tie and clips to keep it out of their face. This is to help prevent the spread of head lice.

Accessories Approved

- **Earrings:** studs and sleepers only.
- **Necklaces:** Fine chains only.
- **Medic alert bracelets.**
- **Sensible watches.**
- **Sunglasses:** For outside to protect eyes.
- **Hair ties:** Navy blue, black or white.
- **Hair Clips:** Small black, navy blue, white or silver.

Shoes Approved

- **School shoes:** Black, brown or navy blue
- **Sneakers:** Predominantly white, black or navy blue. **NO** bright coloured sneakers are allowed and **shoe laces** must be white, black or navy blue.
- **Socks:** Black, navy blue or white.
- **Sandals:** School style only.

All shoes must be appropriate for daily fitness.

Items not approved

- Socks or stockings that are not navy, black or white.
- Non matching shoes.
- Stick on tattoos.
- Platform shoes and high heel shoes.
- Chokers and anklets.
- Rings
- Facial and body piercings.
- Dangly earrings, hooped earrings.
- Nail polish or fake finger nails.
- Make up.
- Hair colour – hair colour is to be a natural tone, not bright or multi coloured.
- Anything deemed inappropriate by the principal.

The consequences of students being out of school uniform will be that they have to change into clothes that are a part of the school uniform, which may be provided by the school for the day.
